Nomination	Sending university nominates its students for the program providing nomination letters and the students' contact details at incoming@itmo.ru	Autumn semester 2025: January 1 – April 30, 2025 Spring semester 2026: July 1 – September 30, 2025
Online application and submission of documents	The students fill out online application form and upload the following application documents in the PDF-format at https://int.itmo.ru/en/application_for_exchange : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passport (<u>should be valid for at least 18 months</u>) • Transcript of records in English • English proficiency confirmation (for non-native speakers) 	Autumn semester 2025: up June 15, 2025 Spring semester 2026: up November 15, 2025
Acceptance confirmation	ITMO considers the submitted applications and confirms if the students are accepted* *online interview may be required	Within two weeks upon the application submission
Invitation procedure	ITMO starts the invitation procedure. Generally, it takes up to 40 days. When the Invitations are issued, ITMO sends them to the students via e-mails.	
Visa application	Upon reception of the Invitations, the students should apply for student visas at the home country. IMPORTANT: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The first entry visa is valid for 90 days • Upon arrival in Saint Petersburg, the visas will be extended by ITMO Migration Services Office. The students should apply for their visas' extension at least 45 days before the first visa expiration date • Visa extension fee is 1,920 rubles 	

<p>Upon-arrival procedures</p>	<p>Upon arrival, the students should:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Visit ITMO Migration Services Office to obtain the migration registration (for the students staying at ITMO dormitories) within 3 days upon the arrival <p>IMPORTANT: if the students stay at a hotel/hostel or rent an apartment, they must get the migration registration from the hotel/hostel administration or the apartment's owner and submit the copy to ITMO Migration Services Office within 7 days upon arrival. The registration is only valid if made on the actual address of the hotel/hostel/apartment.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Submit the following original documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chest X-RAY report if stay at ITMO dormitory (could be done upon arrival) <p>Each student is provided with Buddy's assistance.</p>
